Advanced courses – BTEC Level 3 and A Levels

The columns on the application form have been informed by the questionnaire results, by direct feedback from Year 11 students and by our experience of student choice in previous years. There may be some minor adjustments after we have received all applications but please bear in mind that it would be impossible to satisfy everyone's first choices.

- ◆ For most AS/A courses at least a 'B' at GCSE in a related subject will be required, together with a minimum of 5 'C' grades at GCSE
- ◆ For BTEC Level 3 courses a minimum of 4 'C's will be required, one of which should be English.
- ◆ If you intend following an AS/A and/or BTEC Level 3 programme, choose **four** subjects, **prioritise 1-4 (1 = first choice)**. It is perfectly acceptable to combine AS/A and BTEC Level 3. Please also indicate if you are interested in AS Critical Thinking (*see first page of the application form*).
- ◆ If you intend following a double BTEC Level 3 course, please indicate for **Single Award** or **Double Certificate**. Please identify one or two other subjects that you could also take at AS or Single Award BTEC.
- ◆ It is envisaged that those students studying 4 AS subjects will wish to drop one of them at the end of Year 12 so that their workload is reduced going into Year 13.
- ◆ Our expectation is that all students who have not achieved at least a 'C' grade in both GCSE Maths and English enrol for the resit courses in these subjects

Or

BTEC Level 2

(one year courses)

- ◆ A minimum of 2 'D's at GCSE will be required.
- ◆ You need to choose **one** course from Business, Health & Social Care, Retail or Travel & Tourism. All students will enrol on the resit for GCSE maths and/or English courses as necessary.
