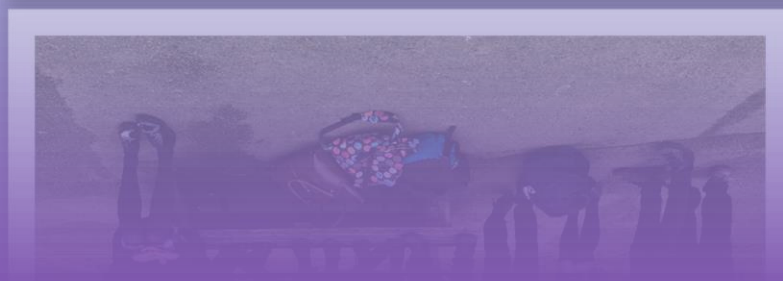

Year 11 Parents' questionnaire results January 2018

Having been distributed at the consultation evening , 53 questionnaires were completed this year.

99% (with 57% strongly) of parents agreed that their child is well looked after at this school, whilst 98% feel that their child feels safe and is taught well at this school. 96% of parents also agree that their child makes good progress and that the school is well led and managed.

In light of identifying areas for improvement, 6% of parents disagreed that their child feels happy; that the school deals well with bullying or that the school responds well to any concerns raised.

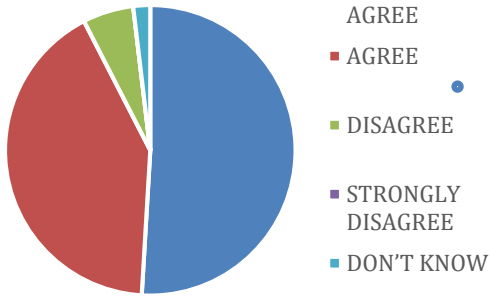

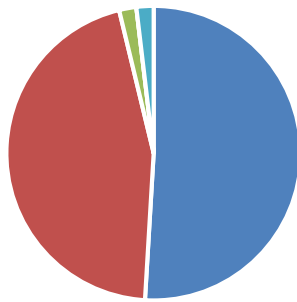
